

Partnership Agency Data Request Form For MTC-Licensed TomTom Basemap Data

The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) has entered into an End User License dated January 1, 2009 with Tom Tom (formerly known as Tele Atlas North America, Inc.) for the use of basemap data (MultiNet USA Version 2009.12) ("the License"). This allows MTC to share the Tom Tom data with its "Partnership Agencies" up to a maximum of 250 "Users", subject to their agreement to comply with the terms of the License (see definitions on page two). MTC will distribute the data to its Partnership Agencies in the ESRI file geodatabase featureclass format in North American Datum 1983 (NAD83) via the MTC Dataportal (<http://dataportal.mtc.ca.gov>).
